# **Aiming At The Invisible -- free sermon outline**

## AIMING AT THE INVISIBLE

### Actions of the Faith Life

Use the main points and Scripture below. Add to it your explanation and illustration and feed your people well.

#### Key Passage

Heb 11:24 By faith Moses, when he became of age, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, 25 choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin, 26 esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt; for he looked to the reward.

27 By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king; for he endured as seeing Him who is invisible. 28 By faith he kept the Passover and the sprinkling of blood, lest he who destroyed the firstborn should touch them.

29 By faith they passed through the Red Sea as by dry land, whereas the Egyptians, attempting to do so, were drowned.

### ACTIONS OF FAITH

The following are actions that were produced out of Moses faith in God in the middle of his trials.

The same actions will be required of us in our journey.

#### 1. REFUSING WRONG IDENTITY

Heb 11:24 By faith Moses, when he became of age, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter,...

#### 2. CHOICE TO SUFFER

25 choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin,

#### 3. DEALING WITH REPROACH

26 esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt; for he looked to the reward.

#### 4. FORSAKING THE TIES OF THE PAST

27 By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king;....

#### 5. ENDURING BY VISION

25...for he endured as seeing Him who is invisible.

#### 6. OBEDIENCE TO GOD'S WORD

28 By faith he kept the Passover and the sprinkling of blood, lest he who destroyed the firstborn should touch them.

#### 7. PRESSING THROUGH

29 By faith they passed through the Red Sea as by dry land, whereas the Egyptians, attempting to do so, were drowned.
