1. The Sword is a weapon.

- A. To defend against the enemies attacks.
- B. To assault the enemies strongholds.
- C. We need to be trained how to use it both offensively and defensively.
- D. Must keep it easily accessible to be ready.

2. Keep Your Sword in Good Condition

- A. By using it. (Ecc.12.11).
- B. Take it out of it's sheath.
- C. Don't allow things to build up on it.

3. Familiarize Yourself with Your Sword

- A. Study it (1 Tim.2.15)
